Sunday, November 17 - Come join us for a relaxing getaway to Central California. Our first stop will be at Roger Rocka's Dinner Theater for a hosted brunch and to see the performance of **Legally Blonde The Musical**. It's a fabulous, award-winning musical so fun it should be illegal! Our accommodations for the night will be at the lovely Tachi Palace Casino Resort. The evening is free to try your hand at Lady Luck.

Monday, November 18 - Today we will travel to the coast stopping for a hosted lunch in Parkfield, the Earthquake Capitol of California. Afterwards we will visit the **Pismo Beach Monarch Butterfly Grove** which is one of only five sites in the state that has counts of over 10,000 butterflies annually. Each year thousands of vibrant orange and black Monarch Butterflies flock to Pismo State Beach, a location essential to their successful migration, seeking shelter from the freezing northern winters. From late October to February, the butterflies cluster in the limbs of towering, majestic Eucalyptus trees flanking a riparian estuary that flows to the Pacific Ocean. Our accommodations for the next five nights will be at the **Sea Crest Ocean Front Hotel**, overlooking the Pacific Ocean. This evening enjoy the sunset and let the sounds of the crashing waves lull you to sleep.

Tuesday, November 19 - Enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel this morning. We will travel south to Santa Barbara where we will have a guided tour of this beautiful city. Afterwards, there is time to browse in the shops and have lunch on your own. This afternoon we will visit the **Santa Barbara Mission**, known as the Queen of the Missions. This Mission has served as a gathering place and spiritual home for many since its establishment in 1786. This evening we will have a hosted dinner at Jocko's.

Wednesday, November 20 - Partake in a hosted breakfast at our hotel this morning. Today we will explore some places in San Luis Obispo. Our first stop will be at the **San Luis Obispo Railroad Museum**. This museum was founded to preserve and present the railroad history of California, and specifically the Central Coast. Our next stop is the locally created, most-talked-about landmark, **Bubblegum Alley**. While the sheer amount of gum is pretty gross, this wall has a fun history, which you will learn about, and is a great place to take pictures. We will have a hosted lunch at the **Madonna Inn** before we go to the Avila Valley Barn. The Avila Barn provides a full farmstand experience, including a country market stocked with pantry goods and thoughtful gifts. Check out the market's cookbooks, kitchen gear, spices, jams and jellies. Make sure you visit their bakery while we are there.

Thursday, November 21 - Enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel this morning. We will have an early afternoon departure for Paso Robles for wine tasting and a tour. Enjoy a hosted dinner at the Paso Robles Inn this evening before going to Sensorio. It was created by acclaimed British artist, Bruce Munro. Field of Light at Sensorio is the perfect nighttime spectacular featuring nearly 60,000 bright, morphing lights spread across 15 rolling acres. This massive walk-through art installation is designed through the use of stemmed glass spheres lit by fiber optic, solar-powered cables, which honor and highlight the natural topography of the land to create a stunning experience.

Friday, November 22 - There will be a hosted breakfast at our hotel this morning. The day is free to enjoy the area. You may decide to stay at the hotel and enjoy the ocean views or take a walk into this quaint town. This evening we will have a hosted dinner at **AJ Spurs** before going to the **Great American Melodrama** for their Holiday Extravaganza. See Scrooge find his Christmas spirit in a heart-warming tale of holiday magic, laugh until your sides ache at the zany characters in a fractured fairy tale opera, and celebrate the music of the season in their Holiday Vaudeville Revue.

Saturday, November 23 - Hosted breakfast at our hotel before we depart for San Juan Bautista. You will have time to visit the Mission or explore the shops after our hosted lunch at **Jardin's Restaurant**. Approximate arrival time in the Bay Area is 6:00 pm.
