<u>Sunday, December 29</u> - Celebrate the New Year as we travel to Southern California. We will have a hosted breakfast at Pea Soup Andersen's. Our accommodations for the next four nights will be at the Ayers Inn & Suites in Costa Mesa. There will be a hosted Manager's Welcome at our hotel upon arrival.

Monday, December 30 - Enjoy a hosted breakfast this morning at our hotel before we depart for the Rose Bowl where we will watch the crews putting the finishing touches on the floats and see the final stage of decorating for the parade. You will have time to have lunch on your own before Band Fest where we see performances featuring the prize winning bands of the 2025 Rose Parade performing the field shows that made them famous. You will have the evening free to enjoy on your own.

Tuesday, December 31 - Start your morning with a hosted breakfast at our hotel before departing for Los Angeles. We will visit the Hammer Museum at University of California Los Angeles. The museum is an art museum and cultural center known for its artist-centric and progressive array of exhibitions. The Hammer Museum opened to the public in 1990. Founded by Dr. Armand Hammer, former Chairman of Occidental Petroleum, it was designed by architect Edward Larrabee Barnes. Here you will have time to visit Armand Hammer's collection of European and American paintings and drawings, along with the current exhibits at the museum. This afternoon we will have time at the Los Angeles Farmer's Market, a favorite destination among locals and tourists since 1934. Here you will have time to enjoy lunch and shopping on your own. Tonight, we ring in the New Year on New York Time with a hosted dinner at our hotel.



- *Wednesday, January 1* The day we have waited for! We are up bright and early as we depart for Pasadena for the 131st Annual Tournament of Roses Parade. You will be provided with a boxed breakfast to enjoy on the coach. We will have reserved grandstand seating with a program and seat cushion. This year's theme is "Best Day Ever" and promises even more beauty, fun and music on parade morning. Bands, floats, and equestrian units from all over the world will participate in the largest and most beautiful floral parade in the world! Afterwards we will return to our hotel where you can relax and watch the football games. This evening we will go to Buca di Beppo for a hosted dinner.
- <u>Thursday, January 2</u> Our final day!! Enjoy a hosted breakfast before we depart for the return trip back home. We will have a hosted lunch at Chalet Basque restaurant. Our approximate arrival time back in the Bay Area will be 6 pm.
